Please also practice these Solfege exercises. They will help to train your musical ear and help you learn to read music. As you sing, practice using your hand signs. Really practice singing the Doh Chord (SMD) song and the Doh Scale. I want ALL of you to be in the Chorus Musicianship Club! The Chorus Musicianship Club requirements are on this sheet and are on our website! www.LPCCsing.org. These exercises are part of the Chorale audition.

Keep working in those theory books! They really help you become a better musician! Remember, only do 1-5 pages at a time, then turn them in so I can correct them and write in helpful hints for the next 5 pages. When you get them back, make the changes for any errors **before** you move on to the next pages.

Practicing the Doh Chord

When Doh is in a **space**, then Me is in a space and Soh is in a space. The notes all in their **place**! When Doh is on a **line**, then Me is on a line and Soh is on a line. To make a tune so **fine**!

Chorus: Musicianship Club Requirements

- 1. Sing the ascending and descending doh scale (drmfsItd`d`tIsfmrd) a cappella, with hand signs and in tune.
- 2. Sing the "Doh-Me-Soh Song" with hand signs, in tune in THREE keys: D, F and G major. The singer must be able to get his/her starting pitch from the piano introduction. The DMS song is on the Chorus Rehearsal CD.
- 3. Sing a melody using notes within a doh pentatonic scale (d r m s I) a cappella by following Ms. Karen's hand signs. These are EXAMPLES not the test.

4. Sight-read a song from the Workbook #1 Songbook, from pages 2 – 5. (Handouts & on line as part of theory book 1)

Chorale Audition for CHORUS members

Dear Chorus Parents.

We will hold auditions for Chorale in May in the 3 weeks following our concert. Audition times are by appointment only and take about 45 minutes. An ADULT is required to sit in on the audition.

Chorale Audition Pre-requisites are: (**See an exception to this rule below.)

- 1. Membership in Chorus Musicianship Club
- 2. Completion of Book 1 Theory.

These tasks, and the work we do in Chorus are designed to prepare our chorus members for their audition Please understand that your child may need to audition several times before they show they have mastered these tasks. Listed below are the Chorale Audition skills we use in our auditions to evaluate their readiness for Chorale.

**EXCEPTION: If your Chorus member is in the 6th – 10th grade, and is NEW to LPCC this semester (started in January), he/she may audition for Chorale with only 30 of the 40 pages completed, but they MUST be a member of the Chorus Musicianship Club prior to auditioning for Chorale.

I. Vocalises: D M S M D (sung on neutral syllable "loo")

- **A. vocal range** (how high and low they sing)
- **B. tone/intonation** (beauty of voice & singing in tune)

II. Singing

A. performance of current Chorus song(s). They will know which 2-3 songs are required, but we will have just completed our LPCC concert, so they should already know their songs.

(Memory, intonation, beauty of the voice & foreign language pronunciation.)

III. Solfege Drills & Ear Training Skills

- A. Solfege Drills: Perform the drills on the Chorus Songsheet and rehearsal CD with handsigns by memory.
- **B. Solfege:** Follow my hand signs full scale (drmfsltd')
- C. Distinguishing DMS within triad: Sing D, M or S when triad is played on piano
- **D. Tonal memory:** Echo a 4-beat musical phrase. They can look at the piano keys as I play.
 - 1. Sing (echo) the phrases back using "loo"
 - 2. Sing (echo) the phrases back using solfege

IV. Sightreading & Part Work

- A. Sightreading: From the Sight-reading materials in Theory Book 1. (half notes, quarter notes, eighth notes & rests)
 - 1. Speak the solfege in rhythm
 - 2. Sing the solfege in rhythm

B. Two-part singing:

- 1. Sing Doh Scale in canon with teacher
- 2. Sing their part in a 2-part song from current Chorus concert program. (Teacher sings the other part.)
- **V. Choir Membership Record:** Attitude, attention span, participation, behavior and attendance record in Chorus.
